Year-Over-Year Notes

McKinley Technology High School's FY23 submitted budget is \$9,974,100. This is an increase of \$916,225 over the FY22 submitted budget. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY21-22, McKinley's projected enrollment was 696. In SY22-23, the school's projected enrollment is 702, an increase of 6 students. McKinley Technology HS received \$2,683 per student eligible for at risk funding, bringing their total At Risk Supplement to \$706,169. McKinley Technology HS received \$163,591 in ESSER III acceleration funding, that is not included in their budget total. This year, security funds are not part of the FY23 school budget allocation and will be managed centrally. Security funding is excluded from both FY22 and FY23 budget totals; thus, this shift does not impact the school's year-over-year calculation or FY23 allocation.
