Year-To-Year Budget Notes

This narrative describes the change from Randle Highlands Elementary School's FY23 submitted budget to their FY24 initial allocation. FY23 submitted budgets include one-time funds (FY23 Mayor's Recovery and Hold Harmless funds), and changes made by principals and school communities from their initial allocation to tailor their resources to their student population. Randle Highland's initial FY23 allocation and submitted FY23 budget are included on the dcpsbudget.com website.

Randle Highlands Elementary School's initial FY24 formula allocation is \$5,483,177. This is an increase of \$158,151 compared to the FY23 submitted budget. School budgets are primarily driven by two factors: enrollment and unique student need. In SY22-23, Randle Highland's projected enrollment was 304. In SY23-24, the school's projected enrollment is 254, a decrease of 50 students. Based on DCPS' school mental health allocation formula, which considers individual student service needs (e.g., special education and 504 service hours), and specialized programming, Randle Highlands ES is receiving 1 additional social workers. Randle Highland is receiving 1 less special education educator due to a decline in students with IEPs and/or students served in self-contained classrooms. Randle Highland is receiving \$2,818 per student eligible for at-risk funding, bringing their total At-Risk Supplement to \$445,234. To support social-emotional and academic needs, additional per-pupil formula funds are allocated to schools serving higher concentrations of students eligible for at-risk funding. Randle Highlands ES is receiving \$22,831 in at-risk concentration funds because over 40% of their student enrollment is eligible for at-risk funding.

Security funds were excluded from school budget allocations since FY22. Security funds will continue to be managed centrally in FY24. Thus, there is no impact to the school's year-over-year comparison. Randle Highland is also receiving \$63,500 in FY24 ESSER III funding. This funding is not included in their budget total because these funds are one-time and supplemental to the school's annual DCPS formula funds. Schools were able to request ESSER III funds to sustain their evidence-based acceleration programming.

Levels of Flexibility Key

Level 1 (L1): Required - Rarely flexible - Any shift in the allocation will maintain the intended purpose of the original allocation.

Level 2 (L2): Flexible with Petition - Principals may petition to repurpose the allocation and must demonstrate how they will meet related programmatic requirements, as applicable.

Level 3 (L3): Flexible - These allocations are optional and may be budgeted at the principal's discretion.
